The Collision 2019 volunteer programme seeks to recruit a diverse and engaged group of volunteers who will work cross-functionally to support all aspects of the live event.

600 volunteers are required to work two full-day shifts (approximately 16 hours in total).

In return, volunteers will gain access to the event as general attendees on days when they are not assigned a shift.

- hoping to gain hands-on experience in a fast paced environment.
